


REGULAR ACTIVITIES ORIENTATION PROGRAMS



CELEBRATIONS AND OBSERVANCES OF NATIONAL DAYS




> 75th Independence Day was celebrated with march past, tree plantation drive (35 saplings were planted by NSS Volunteers), and a cultural program with Tiranga.

➤ Human Right's Day was celebrated on 10th December, 2022 with poster presentation on the theme "Right to life, right to smile".



OUTREACH PROGRAMS




> Distribution of old clothes among the Slum dwellers on 11th April, 2022
