RULEBOOK

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS :-

1. All participants must report half an hour before the commencement of the particular event.
2. Obscenity or vulgarity in any form in an event will lead to immediate disqualification.
3. The decision of the judges will be final for every event.
4. Participants are requested to take care for their own belongings.
5. The details, rules etc. are subject to change.
6. The event will be cancelled in case of less than three participants.
7. All participants must register their names within 12th of September, 2019. Registration will be closed after 3 P.M. on 12th of September.

EVENT RULES

1. EASTERN VOCALS, WESTERN VOCALS AND RABINDRA SANGEET :

- Pre-recorded songs with lyrics are strictly forbidden.
- If required, participants must bring their own musical instruments.
- Time limit – 3+1 minutes.
- Team size – 1 vocalist.

2. CLASSICAL DANCE AND CREATIVEDANCE :

- Allowed eastern classical dance forms: Bharatnatyam, Kathak, Odissi, Manipuri, Kathakali, Kuchupudi, Mohiniattam, Sattriya, Folk, Rabindra-nritya.
- Allowed western classical dance forms : Jazz, Breaking, Locking, Popping, Krumping; Latin & Ballroom: Waltz, Tango, Cha-Cha, Samba, Salsa, Rock-n-Roll.
- Participants must wear the appropriate costume of the dance form being performed.
- Tracks and props (if any), must be submitted 15minutes prior to the event time.
- Time limit – 4+1 minutes.

3. DEBATE :

- **Motion of Debate:**
The Article 1 of the Indian Constitution begins with the phrase 'India, i.e., Bharat, ...'. This phrase needs no amendment because India and Bharat still coexist.
- Team size – 2 members.
- Speakers will be allowed for 3 minutes to present their argument. After all the speakers have presented their respective arguments, participants will be allowed 2 minutes for a rebuttal.
- Participants may speak in English OR Bengali OR Hindi. Change of language in between a speech is not allowed.
- One member of each team must speak 'For' the motion, while the other must speak 'Against'.
- Digressing (speaking off- topic) and/or interrupting another speaker will incur penalty.

4. SHORT FILM:

- Theme – **The journey of a road (ektirastaritikatha).**
- Duration – Maximum 10 minutes.
- Participants should not take help from others.

5. QUIZ :

- Team size – 3 members
- There will be an elimination round in case more than 5 teams participate.

6. ANTAKSHARI :

- Team size – 2 members
- Further Rules will be provided on spot.

7. PHOTOGRAPHY :

- Time limit - 3 hrs.
- Theme will be announced on the spot.
- All photographs must be taken within the college campus.
- Any digital camera may be used. Mobile phone cameras are not allowed. Photo dimensions must be 2048×158 pixels.
- Up to 3 photos may be submitted for evaluation per participant.
- Participants must bring the required accessories (USB cable, SD card reader, etc.) to transfer the photos taken to the laptop, at the venue.

8. CREATIVE WRITING :

- Topic for composition will be provided on the spot.
- Participants are free to interpret the topic as they wish. Prose and poetry are allowed.
- Writing paper will be provided. Pens, pencils, etc. must be brought by the participant.
- Any form of profanity will lead to disqualification of the entry.
- Participants may write in either English OR Bengali OR Hindi.
- Time limit – 1 hour.

9. DECLAMATION :

- Students will be given a topic on the previous day. They need to prepare a speech and present it.
- Speaking time –2 minutes.

10. TREASURE HUNT:

- Team size-2
- Rules will be declared on spot.

11. RANGOLI:

- Participant should not take help from any other person.
- Further Rules will be provided on spot.
- Preferable size: 24"X18"

12. EDUCATION MODEL PRESENTATION:

- Team size-2
- Each team can submit one model
- Time for explaining the model- 5 minutes

13. ONE-ACT PLAY:

- Team size : 1 – 6 members
- Time limit – 8+2 minutes
- Tracks and props (if any), must be submitted 15minutes prior to the event time.

14. RECITATION :

- Time limit – 3+1 minutes.

- Participant should provide three photocopies of the piece at the time reporting.
