On that note, the Women's Studies Centre, Bethune College has decided to organize a **Poster making and Essay Writing Competition** which will be open to both UG & PG students.

POINTS TO BE KEPT IN MIND :

1. Languages preferred for **essay** writing or **Poster** making are :
BENGALI & ENGLISH.
2. Topic for **Essay** Writing Competition :
"Relevance of Studying Women's Studies in Today's Context"
3. Topic for **Poster** Making Competition :
"Amader Katha-(Our Narratives)"
4. Word limit for **essay** : 500 words.
5. The **essay** can be written on A4 sheets and scanned documents made into PDFs will be accepted.

6. Typed **Essay** will also be accepted and it must be submitted in **PDF form only**. (Use MS Word/Google Docs/WPS Office or any other software of your convenience)
 7. The **poster** is preferred to be done on one-fourth of a chart paper and the scanned PDF is to be submitted.
 8. The name of the PDF file must contain your name, department and the ongoing semester. For example, if your name is ABC and you belong to UG SEM 4, English department, then your file name should be as follows :
- ABC_UGSEM4_English
9. Everybody can participate irrespective of their participation in the webinar.
