GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The registered participants for any event should confirm their presence at the respective registration desks with their valid student ID Card at least 30 minutes prior to the event. Failure to do so may render the participation void. If any student has not received their ID Card, they have to provide their Payment receipt at the registration desk.
2. If there be a necessity for any member substitution (in case of group events) within the team, the event coordinators should be informed at least one day prior to the event.
3. All participants/teams are asked to keep a backup of their respective tracks along with them.
4. All participants/teams are asked to send the audio/video clippings to their respective event coordinators.
5. For any queries, the participants may contact the event coordinators.
6. In all matters related to judging, the decision of the judges will be final and binding.

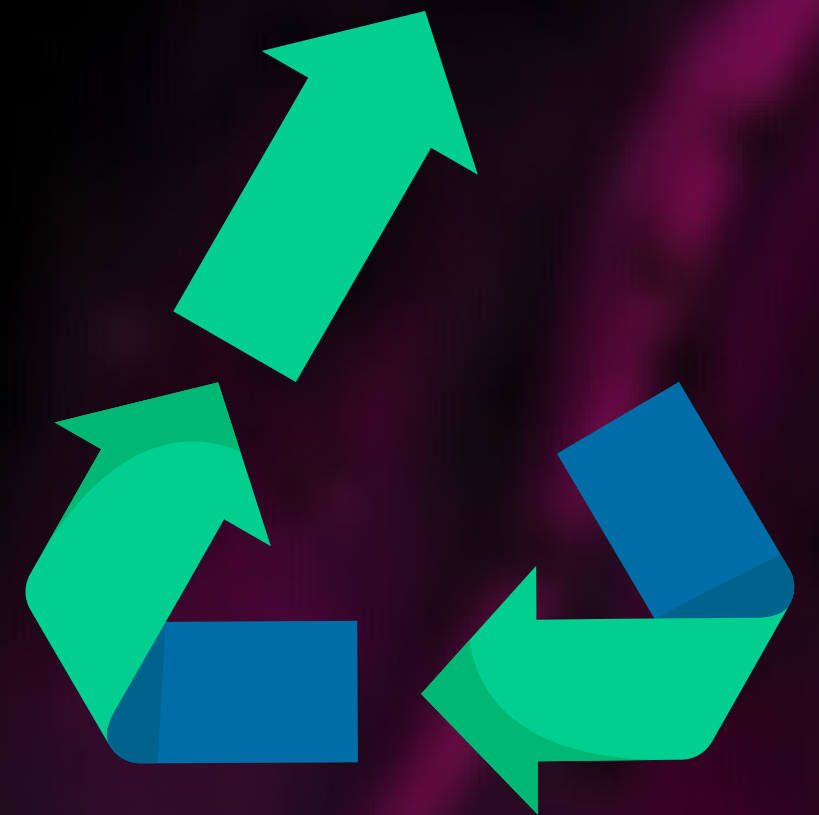

Rules:

1. The debate will be in the Cambridge format.
2. Participants may speak in English, Bengali or Hindi.
3. One member should speak for the motion while the other should speak against the motion.
4. Each speaker will be allowed 3 minutes to present their argument. A warning bell at the end of 2 minutes and a final bell at the end of 3 minutes will be given.
5. 1 minute will be allowed for rebuttal which will be in the form of answering questions from the fellow contestants. Please refrain from cross-questioning.

6. The participant can choose to answer the question posed to them.

(Answering is recommended as marks are allotted for rebuttal.)

7. Digressing from the topic or interrupting another speaker will incur a penalty.

8. Use of unfair means like electronic devices during one's speech will lead to immediate disqualification.

9. Reading out entirely from a prepared speech is prohibited.

10. Non-Parliamentary behaviour or gestures will not be tolerated. Any insulting/demeaning/hateful statement to a particular individual will not be entertained. This might lead to disqualification.

Rules:

1. The participants must come up to the venue with their valid and proper IDs and a soft copy of their registration.
2. There is no particular theme for the short films. However, the film must be shot locally (in Kolkata and nearby districts).
3. The entries may include documentaries, short films, animation or experimental art forms.
4. Each submission's time limit is 5+2. Exceeding the time limit will incur a penalty. This includes opening and closing credits, which must be clearly mentioned.
5. The crew should not consist of more than five people (e.g., director, cinematographer, editor, light and sound). There are no caps for the number of actors or cast members. The crew must all be present on the day of the event. If a member cannot be present on the day of the screening, they must inform the event coordinator before the day of the event. The entire team will be penalised if a crew member is absent without prior information.

6. Cross-college crew members will not be accepted for registration. However, the same will not apply to actors who may or may not be students or belong to the same institution as the crew members.
7. The film may be shot at the team's convenience using phone or video cameras.
8. The film must be shot HORIZONTALLY using either 16:9 ratio or 4:3 ratio.
9. The criteria for judging will be originality, group coordination, composition, light and sound, cinematography, script, acting, and relevance.
10. The teams are requested to upload their entries on YouTube. A Google form will be provided for this purpose, where links to the submission will be shared. However, they may also carry another backup of their submissions (via hard drive) in case of any technical difficulties.
11. The teams whose entries have existing dialogue must submit a hard copy of their script.
12. If the film has sections/narration in vernacular language, English/Bangla subtitles may be added.
13. Ensure that all content in your film (including footage, music, images, props, etc.) is your own. If you include any copyrighted or trademarked content, you must be able to provide written permission for its use. Entries containing any unauthorised content will be disqualified.
14. Explicit, vulgar, and politically biased content will not be entertained. Abusive words, actions and obscenity of any kind will lead the whole team to disqualification.
