Instructions to the Authors

1. Margin : Top: 1.2", Bottom: 0.6", Left: 0.8", Right: 0.6", Typed area: 8.5"×11"
2. Orders of Content:
 - i. Title page with Authors details,
 - ii. Abstract (300 words) and Keyword,(max 8)
 - iii. Introduction,
 - iv. Methods,
 - v. Results,
 - vi. Conclusions,
 - vii. Acknowledgement,
 - viii. References,
 - ix. Appendices.
3. 'Times Roman ' will be used in title and text strictly
4. Size of letters:
 - i. Paper title: 12 point, bold;
 - ii. Authors name : 10 points, bold;
 - iii. Affiliations: 10 points,
 - iv. Subheadings: 10 points,
 - v. Text: 10 points,
 - vi. References: 8 points.
5. Space between lines:
 - i. 1.5 line between title and Authors
 - ii. 1.5 line between abstract and keywords
 - iii. 1.5 line with in text
 - iv. 1 line gap between paragraphs
 - v. 1 line space before and after each sub heading
 - vi. 1st line of the paragraph will be indented

6. References will be in APA style. For citing reference within text mention authors name & years of publication following standard convention.
7. Submit papers written in MS Words only. *
8. Figures, Tables and Photographs should be included after References, having title and number which is also mentioned in the paper. Decision for publication of figures, tables and photographs in colour or black & white in hardcopy is the right of Editors.
9. Supplementary data should be included in Appendices following same pattern as mentioned in point no. 8 and will not be published in hard copy of the journal.
10. Plagiarism will not be appreciated.

Note : *For point No 7. Submit papers written preferably in MS Word. For Vernacular articles, papers should be written in Unicode. Pdf format will be accepted only when there will be technical difficulties in writing in MS Word.
