  2. **Detailed Feedback on the Course:** 10 marks [Online, through Google Form, on **19/09/2022**, link to be shared at 7 p.m.]
  3. **Attendance:** 15 marks [Minimum 60% attendance for the entire course is required for certification]
  4. **Dissertation:** 15 marks [Write-up on students' visit to Swami Vivekananda Ancestral House & Cultural Centre to be submitted individually by students to respective Departments. 10 marks on write-up + 5 marks for attendance on day of visit- Completed ]
  5. **Departmental Paper Presentation:** 30 marks [Offline, on 13/09/2022 & 14/09/2022, details below\*\*]

\*\* Departmental Paper Presentation:

- ✓ On **13/09/2022** Departments of Bengali, Botany, English, Economics, Chemistry, Physics, History and Hindi are to present their papers
- ✓ On **14/09/2022**, Departments of Mathematics, Philosophy, Computer Science, Political Science, Statistics, Psychology, Sanskrit, Zoology are to present their papers.
- ✓ On both days students of all departments and their teachers must be present at the Centenary Hall from 3 to 5 p.m.
- ✓ A list of topics on which papers may be presented shall follow this Notice. Students may also present papers on any topic that is related to the content of the course or the lectures held.
- ✓ Students shall be given 10 minutes to present their paper. Use of PPT is desirable.
- ✓ Each department shall select a single topic and work collectively to prepare a paper within 1000 words that shall be presented by one or two representative students of the department.
