BETHUNE COLLEGE COVID SOUAD

Amidst the second wave of the COVID-19 pandemic, the *Bethune College Covid Squad* was started as an initiative of Students' Activity Cell with roughly twelve students from Semesters four and six, on April 28, 2021, with the purpose of providing help to the families of the students and staff of our college. However, as the group expanded, it started to extend help to people from all over the state. Currently, the group consists of **60**



student volunteers and has been able to help almost **150** people till date with all kinds of help, from oxygen cylinders and hospital beds to food facilities and RTPCR tests and a lot more.

ETHICS & VALUE EDUCATION COURSE

A 30 Hour-Certificate Course on *Ethics & Value Education* has been designed from the academic session 2020-2021, for the undergraduate students of Semester 1 and 2 of Bethune College, under the able supervision of **Prof. (Dr.) Krishna Roy**, Principal, Bethune College. This online course helps the students to awaken their consciences and enhance their abilities to do or not to do certain things in daily life. The internal members of the Ethics & Value Education Committee have organised a series of online

lectures based on a framed syllabus.
