Eligibility criteria for Jyotsnamoyee De Teaching Fellow:

Candidates must hold M.Sc. in Pure Mathematics with a minimum of 55% marks.

Eligibility criteria for Tarak Sudha Teaching Fellow in Pure Mathematics:

Candidates must hold M.Sc. in Pure Mathematics with a minimum of 55% marks.

Eligibility criteria for Tarak Sudha Teaching Fellow in Applied Mathematics or Computer Science:

Candidates must hold M.Sc. or MCA in Applied Mathematics or Computer Science (Preferable) with a minimum of 55% marks.
